

ORDINANCE

Parksley No. 90-3

At a regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Parksley, Virginia, held on the 10 day of December, 1990, at which the Mayor and 6 members of the Council were present, the following Ordinance was adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

1. If any person who has passed his or her thirteenth (13th) birthday shall engage in the activity commonly known as "Trick or Treat" or any other activity of similar character or nature under any name whatsoever, such person shall be guilty of Class 4 misdemeanor. Nothing herein shall be construed as prohibiting any parent, guardian or other responsible person having lawfully in his or her custody a child who has not passed his or her thirteenth (13th) birthday from accompanying such child who is playing "Trick or Treat" for the purpose of caring for, looking after or protecting such child.
2. If any person shall engage in the activity commonly known as "Trick or Treat" or any other activity of similar character or nature under any name whatsoever after 9:00 P.M., such person shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor.
3. This Ordinance shall be in effect on any night on which Halloween is generally observed.
4. A Class 4 misdemeanor shall be punished as provided in the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.
