

ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE KEEPING OF INOPERATIVE MOTOR
VEHICLES ON PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF PARKSLEY

At a regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Parksley, Virginia, held on the 12th day of April, 2004, at which the Mayor and all members of Council were present, the following ordinance was adopted by vote as follows:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARKSLEY AS
FOLLOWS:

1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to keep, except within a fully enclosed building or structure, or otherwise shielded or screened from view, on any property within the corporate limits of the Town of Parksley, any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, as such are defined in Code of Virginia, Section 46.2-100 which is inoperative. As used in this section, an "inoperative motor vehicle" shall mean any motor vehicle which is not in operating condition or which for a period of thirty days or longer has been partially or totally disassembled by the removal of tires and wheels, the engine or other essential parts required for operation of the vehicle or on which there are displayed neither valid license plates nor a valid inspection decal.

2. Any person, firm or corporation violating or permitting the violation of this Ordinance by allowing anyone to keep an inoperative motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer on their property shall be guilty of a civil penalty, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.


3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day a violation of this ordinance is committed, continued, or permitted by such person, firm, or corporation, and shall be punishable as herein above provided.

4. It is hereby declared than an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be effective immediately.
