

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Parksley Town Council is a Virginia Municipal Corporation located in Accomack County, Virginia, that operates a water works system to provide water to the citizens of said Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Parksley Town Council recently learned that the Division of Water Supply Engineering of the Virginia Department of Health is currently considering the adoption of a regulation which would result in the assessment and collection of a Waterworks Operation fee, namely VR 355-18-014; and,

WHEREAS, the adoption of the aforesaid regulation would result in a fee being assessed to each water user in the Town of Parksley; and,


WHEREAS, the Parksley Town Council deems such a fee to be unnecessary, unjust and unfair, and of no real benefit to the residents of the Town of Parksley or any other community affected thereby; now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Parksley Town Council objects to and registers its opposition to the adoption of the aforesaid proposed regulation by the Virginia Department of Health which would impose a Waterworks Operation fee upon the Town of Parksley and/or its residents receiving water from its waterworks system because same would be unnecessary, unjust, and unfair and of no real benefit to the residents of the Town of Parksley or any other community affected thereby.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Town of Parksley hereby request the Accomack County Board of Supervisors, Senator Thomas K.

Norment, Jr., and Delegate Robert S. Bloxom to take all necessary and appropriate action to prevent adoption of the aforesaid regulation.
