Councilman Taylor made a motion that the Personnel Policy go into effect on November 1, 2020, passes via voice vote.


Councilwoman Bundick made a motion to approve the Code of Conduct for gazebo use, tabled.

New Business


Mayor Russell requested the council consider getting estimates to repair the parking lot black-top in the near future.
