J. Stoll- 24205 Mary St.- Mr. Stoll expressed concern about a home on Bennett St. that appeared to have the back door vandalized. The Council informed Mr. Stoll they'd follow up with Chief Greer and the homeowner.

Supervisor P. Muhly- Supervisor Muhly expressed his concern and displeasure regarding homes with excessive vehicles and inquired about our ordinance regarding this.

Council Discussion: Old Business

- 1. Downtown Revitalization Project- Clerk Lewis gave a brief update regarding the project. Anne Doyle from A-NPDC will be putting out a request for bids for a mural. Large planters will be ordered for Bennett St. and Dunne Ave. The lightbulbs and globes on the antique streetlamps will be replaced. Fencing for the west side of the downtown area is going to be paid for by the grant. String lighting for the stage area is going to be installed.
- 2. GIS Water Meter Installation Update- Mr. John Bourcier from Consolidated Pipe attended the meeting to provide an update. The meter installation process has begun. While the meters are being installed, the Town is also surveying the meter boxes to see if they need to be replaced and will replace them as needed. The installation of a meter takes approximately 5-7 minutes, and the installer can complete approximately 25 meters on a "good day".
