Old Business:

- 1. Hortco Quote: Clerk Lewis provided pricing information from Hortco Garden Center to replant the flower baskets, flower beds, and sidewalk planters. The quote for everything is \$3,280-3,850. Councilman Taylor made a motion to revisit in the spring because flowers die in the winter. The motion was not seconded and died. Councilman RW Marshall made a motion to purchase flowers for the baskets and beds. Seconded by Councilwoman Welch.

<u>Police Department</u>—Chief Greer provided his monthly report of activities to the council. Councilman York read the PD Report aloud.

<u>Public Works</u>- M. McCready- Installation of the water main on Willis Street is completed. One of the main gate valves isn't working properly and will need to be repaired.

<u>Clerk</u>- L. Lewis – Clerk Lewis noted that we will have to hire another part-time employee for the town office.

<u>Parksley Fire Company</u>- Daryn Fussell, President- Mr. Fussell stated that in August, PVFC ran 142 EMS calls and 30 fire or fire-related calls. The Labor Day Barbecue event was very successful. The new command vehicle is being put into service.

<u>J. Welch</u>- Reported having several residents complain about the Davis trash cans being put down in the road, instead of their yard. Davis has been contacted about this issue once already.

Adjournment:

Councilman Marshall made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:53 PM. Seconded by Councilman York. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned.
